

## Information Clause

According to Article 13(1),(2) of the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter „GDPR”) we hereby inform you that:

1) The Joint Controllers of your personal data as a person interested in participating in the Infoshare 2025 Conference as a Journalist are: the Infoshare Foundation with its seat at Grunwaldzka 472b, 80-309 Gdańsk, KRS 0000374384 (National Court Register), NIP 9571047732 (Tax Identification Number) & Infoshare Sp. z o. o. with its seat at Grunwaldzka 472b, 80-309 Gdańsk, KRS 0000588009 (National Court Register), NIP 9571082154, hereinafter “Controller”.

2) The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer who can be reached at: [iod@infoshare.pl](mailto:iod@infoshare.pl).

3) The personal data provided by you will be processed:

a) for purposes of conducting the process of selecting journalists for the Infoshare 2025 Conference in accordance with Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR,

b) for purposes related to the participation of the Journalist at the Infoshare 2025 Conference in accordance with “Media Registration Terms” (hereinafter: Terms), pursuant to Art. 6(1)(b) of the GDPR.

4) Your data will not be disclosed to Recipients. It can, however, be processed by Processors i.e. entities the Controller will be cooperating with in order to realize the Infoshare 2025 Conference.

5) a) for purposes of conducting the process of selecting Speakers for the Infoshare 2025 Conference in accordance with Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR,

b) for purposes related to the participation of the Journalist at the Infoshare 2025 Conference in accordance with Terms, pursuant to Art. 6(1)(b) of the GDPR. Your data will be stored from the moment your consent is granted, during the period of cooperation in accordance with the Terms, and for the time necessary for the

performance of tasks connected with the Terms. Your data will be stored thereafter for a period corresponding to the Terms – related claims' limitation period or for as long as a legal obligation exists regarding storing accounting and financial documentation.

6) You have the right to access your data, rectify them, delete them, limit or oppose their processing, their portability, and the right to lodge an objection against the processing of your data by the Controller. You have the right to withdraw the consent to data processing at any time, which shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

7) In case of a GDPR personal data breach you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Polish supervisory authority for personal data protection regulations which is: the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (pl: Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych).

8) The provision of personal data is voluntary, however with regards to Art. 3 (a) it is obligatory in order to participate in the Infoshare 2025.

9) Your personal data is not subject to automated processing.
